Quiz Competition on the Occasion of Constitution Day

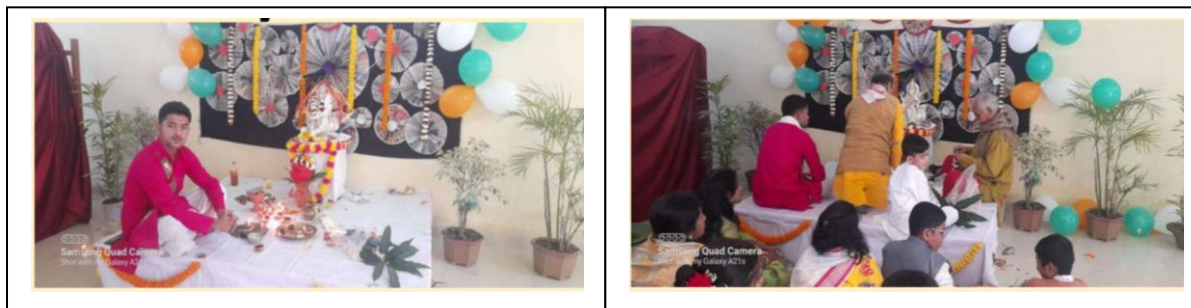

Felicitation of Smt. Anushka Tarangini

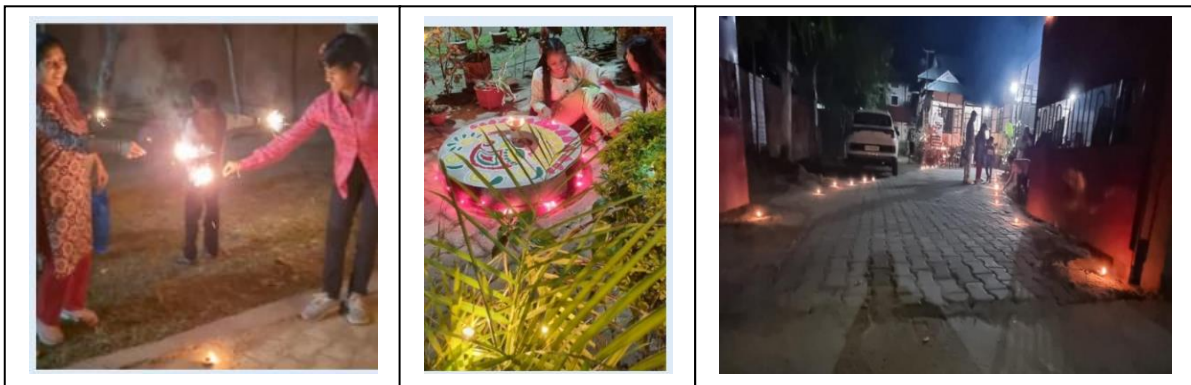
