Importance of Eye Donation





On 18/05/2022, an awareness program on the "Importance of Eye Donation" was organized by the Youth Red Cross Unit of Dr. Rohini Kanta Barua Law College, Dibrugarh. The Resource person Dr. Ramesh Kumar Agarwalla, who is the founder Director of Drishti Netralaya, Dibrugarh Assam, accompanied with his junior colleague Dr. Priyal Agarwal and other dignitaries of the Red Cross Society. The programme was started with lighting of lamp by the dignitaries, followed by a welcome speech from the Principal of the college.

The resources person enlightened the audience how a simple step of eye donation after one's death can allow another life to see and embrace this beautiful universe. other internal and external organs the human eye is the organ that remains functional for 6-7 hrs after the death. Meanwhile if the eye is preserved and taken care of it could be of immense help to someone who has been blindfolded by the nature itself. Dr. Agarwalla very clearly explained that a person can also voluntarily get his/her wish of eye donation executed by intimating his/ her family members

and the eye donation bank, while he/ she is alive. The programme was ended with a vote of thanks offered by Ms. Manalisa Medhi, Assistant Professor of Dr. Rohini Kanta Barua Law College.

Awareness Programme of Blood Donation





On 21st May, 2022, an awareness program on the "Importance of Blood Donation" was organized by the Youth Red Cross Unit of Dr. R.K.B. Law College, Dibrugarh. The Resource person was Dr. Zarika Ahmed, a senior Medical Officer under Dept. of Pathology, Assam Medical College and Hospital, Dibrugarh (Assam) who was accompanied with Mr. Sudeep Ghosh from Lions Club of Dibrugarh and other Dignitaries of the Red Cross Society.

The programme was started with lighting of lamp, followed by presentation of college chorus by the students of the college and then a welcome speech from the Principal of the college.

The resources person enlightened the audience with the importance of Blood donation. She shared the history of blood donation which was first started in 1680 and how it was first experimented. Then the different criteria for blood donation were explained like the age should be between 18 to 65 yrs. and weight should be above 50kg, the Hemoglobin should be 12.5gm%. And after donating one's blood, precautions like not doing heavy workouts, drinking juice and water and proper meal should be taken. Dr. Zarika further explained how one becomes healthier after giving their blood as new RBC develops which are much more efficient in carrying oxygen. Further she added that only 300ml of blood can be donated after every 3 months in male and after 4 months in female. The blood donated is then kept in refrigerators and can be used within 35days and the plasma can be stored for a year.

After delivery of the Resource Person, other speakers also motivated students to come forward for the noble work of blood donation. The programme was ended with a vote of thanks delivered by Sri. R. K. Agarwalla, Sr. Lecturer of the college.







On 22nd May, 2022, The Youth Red Cross Wing of Dr. R.K.B. Law College in Association with Rotary Club of Dibrugarh & Senior Citizen Forum, Dibrugarh organized a "*Free Health Check-up Camp for Senior Citizen*" from 10.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. The Programme got started with the felicitation of Sri Prutul Baruah, President Rotary Club, Dibrugarh, by Dr. Gautomi Dutta Borah, Principal, Dr. R.K.B. Law College, Dibrugarh, with a Phoolam Gamucha. Thereafter, the President of Rotary Club delivered welcome speech which was followed by a speech of Sri. The Free Health Check-up Camp was comprised with investigation and advice from Medical Practioner of the following departments.

Besides that, Blood pressure, Pulse rate and oxygen percentage have also been checked. Blood samples have been collected for investigating Hb%, RBS, TSH & Uric Acid. A team of Doctors from AMC&H, H.M. Hospital and members of various Pharmaceuticals Companies extended their support for smooth running of the Health Check-up Camp. The camp was successfully concluded with the free health checkup of sixty five (65) persons.



On 16th September 2022, the Youth Red Cross Unit of Dr. R.K.B. Law College in association with the Red Cross Society of Dibrugarh and in collaboration with Archana Hospital, Marwari Yuva Manch, Dibrugarh, Pragati Branch and Blood Conservation Department (Blood Bank) of Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh organized a "*Blood Donation Camp*" from 10.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. Dr. Pranit Kumar Chowdhary, President, Red Cross Society Dibrugarh, in the



inaugural session emphasized the importance of blood donation and urged the people to extend their cooperation.
